An intense period

The UIRR Team has come through an unprecedentedly intense period during the first six months of 2018: parallel assisting the deliberations of the Combined Transport Directive amendment in the European Parliament and the European Council Working Group, two major conferences and an exhibition in the European Parliament, as well as putting on the once-in-three years General Assembly that reconfirms the association's strategy and elects its Board of Directors. This usual work of an industry association is going on with an unchanged team. Resources and priorities had to be reallocated and optimized. One such

decision was to combine the Q1.2018 and Q2.2018 Newsletters.

After the dynamic expansion of 2017, UIRR member Combined Transport Operators and CT Terminal Managers realised a positive growth albeit at a gradually reducing rate over the first half of 2018, as rail freight quality performance and the SNCF strikes in France hindered performance. The UIRR CT Sentiment Index remains at "slightly positive", which – despite the highly disruptive French railway strikes – indicates the continued confidence of the sector for the coming twelve months.

Both European legislators working on the amendment of the Combined Transport Directive have achieved milestones by the end of the period:

- The European Parliament TRAN Committee has adopted its compromise position with a decisive majority of 34:4 – a position that UIRR overwhelmingly endorsed.
- The Bulgarian Council Presidency under the influence of the parallel discussions on the road legislation – has just missed reaching a partial general approach, and therefore closed the semester with a progress report.

UIRR will continue to assist the Member States and the Austrian Presidency with a view to catalyse the achievement of a general approach by the December Transport Ministerial Council meeting. This general approach should resemble as much as possible the consensus achieved in Parliament as the TRAN position adequately identifies and addresses the issues contained in the original Commission draft. The same topics are being addressed in the European Council Working Group deliberations

The EU project that is to produce the Common Rail Service Facility Portal has commenced its activities. UIRR performs a prime mission within the consortium busy with the work. The first milestone will be reached by the end of Summer. Simultaneously, UIRR is busy on three other EU projects, which include ELETA, Aeroflex and Optiyard. A fourth project, HubHarmony was concluded in the same period.

UIRR's General Assembly in May has reconfirmed the association's mission and adjusted its delivery strategy. A new Board of Directors has been elected.

Enhancement of Intermodal Transport

TRAN Committee votes decisively on CT Directive amendment

June/July 2018

The European Parliament adopted its consensus position with a vote in the TRAN Committee 34:4 on 10 July. Accordingly, the mandate has been issued to Rapporteur Daniela Aiuto to engage in trialogue discussions with the European Council upon the adoption of its position.
