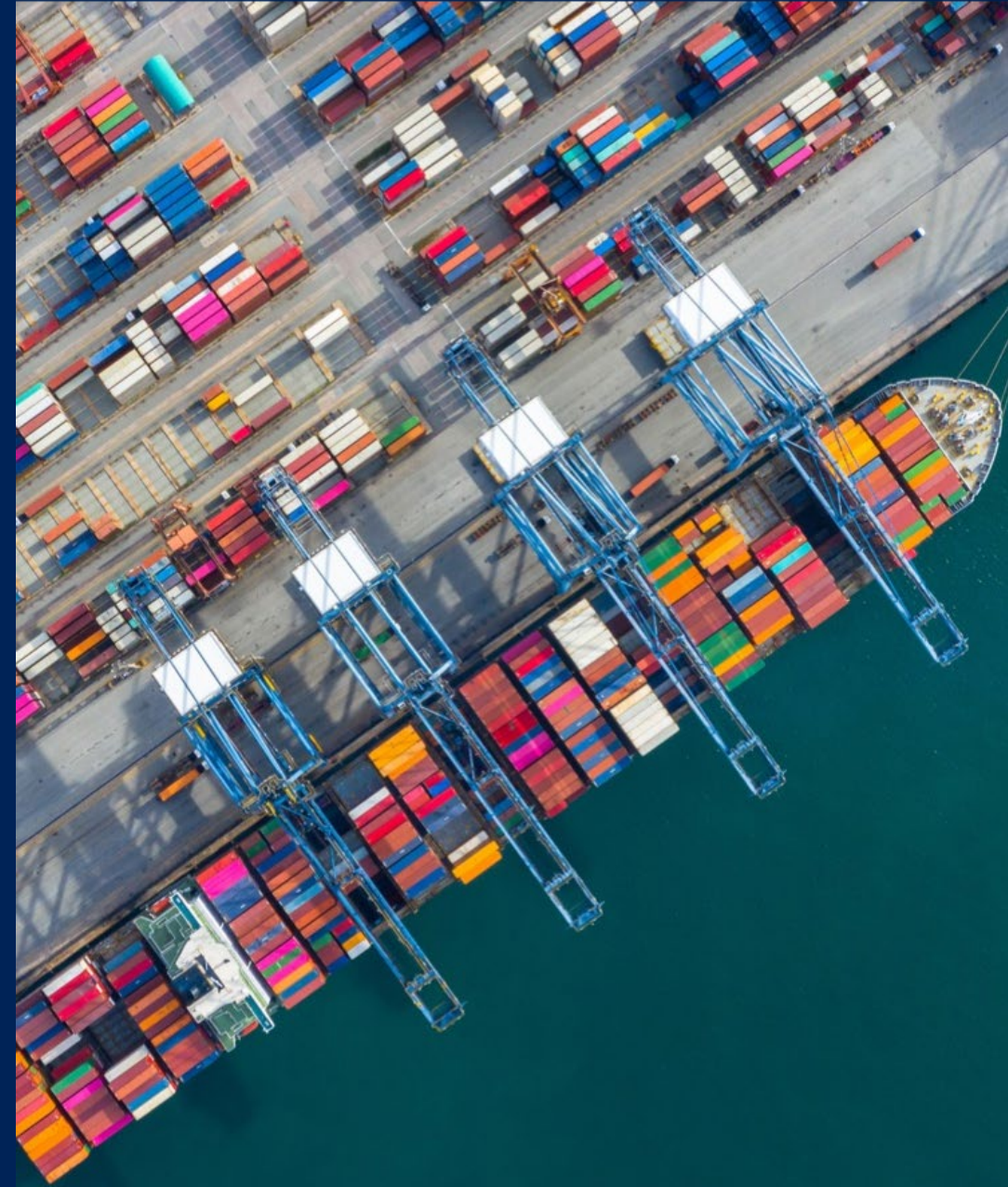

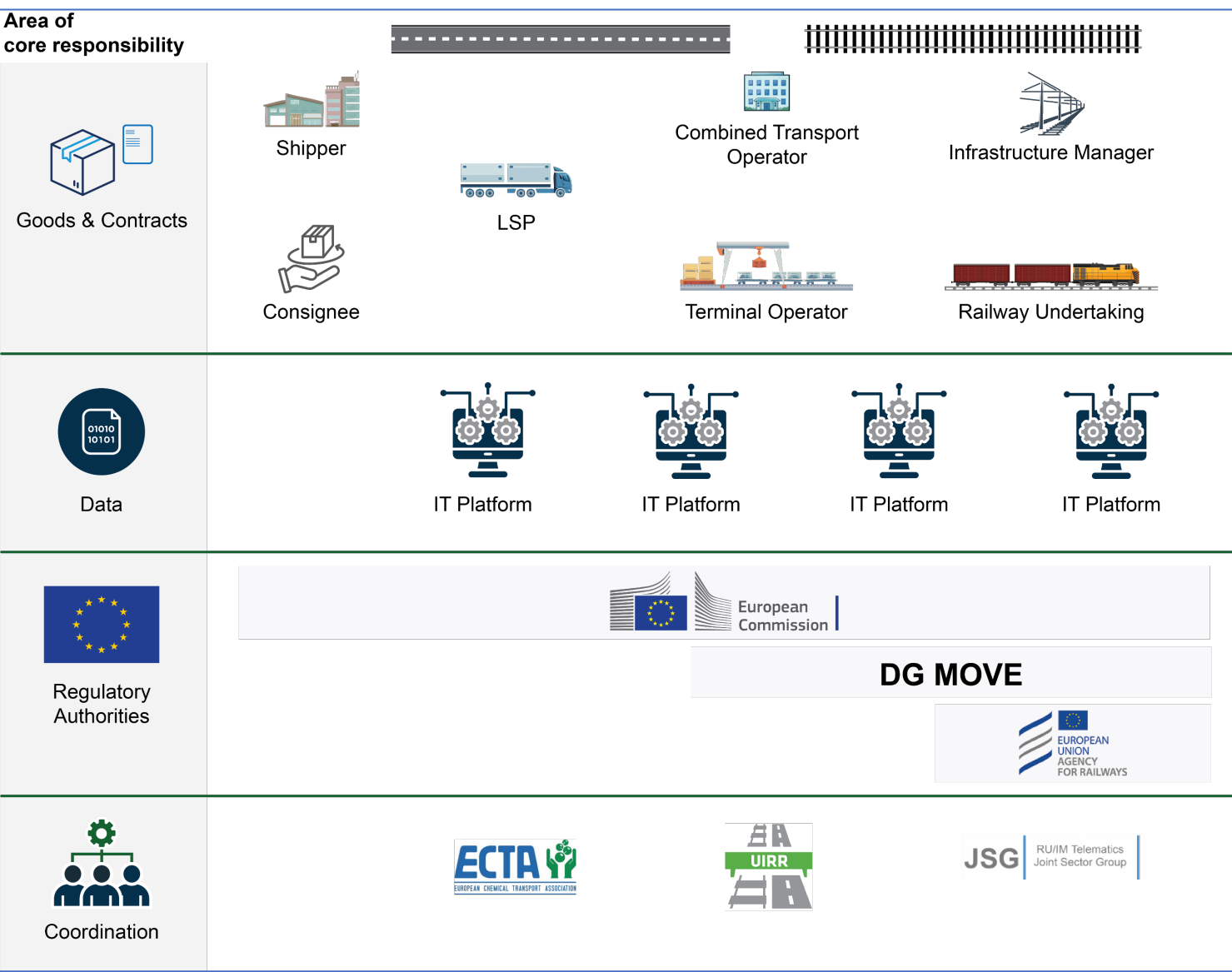

# Rail Connected

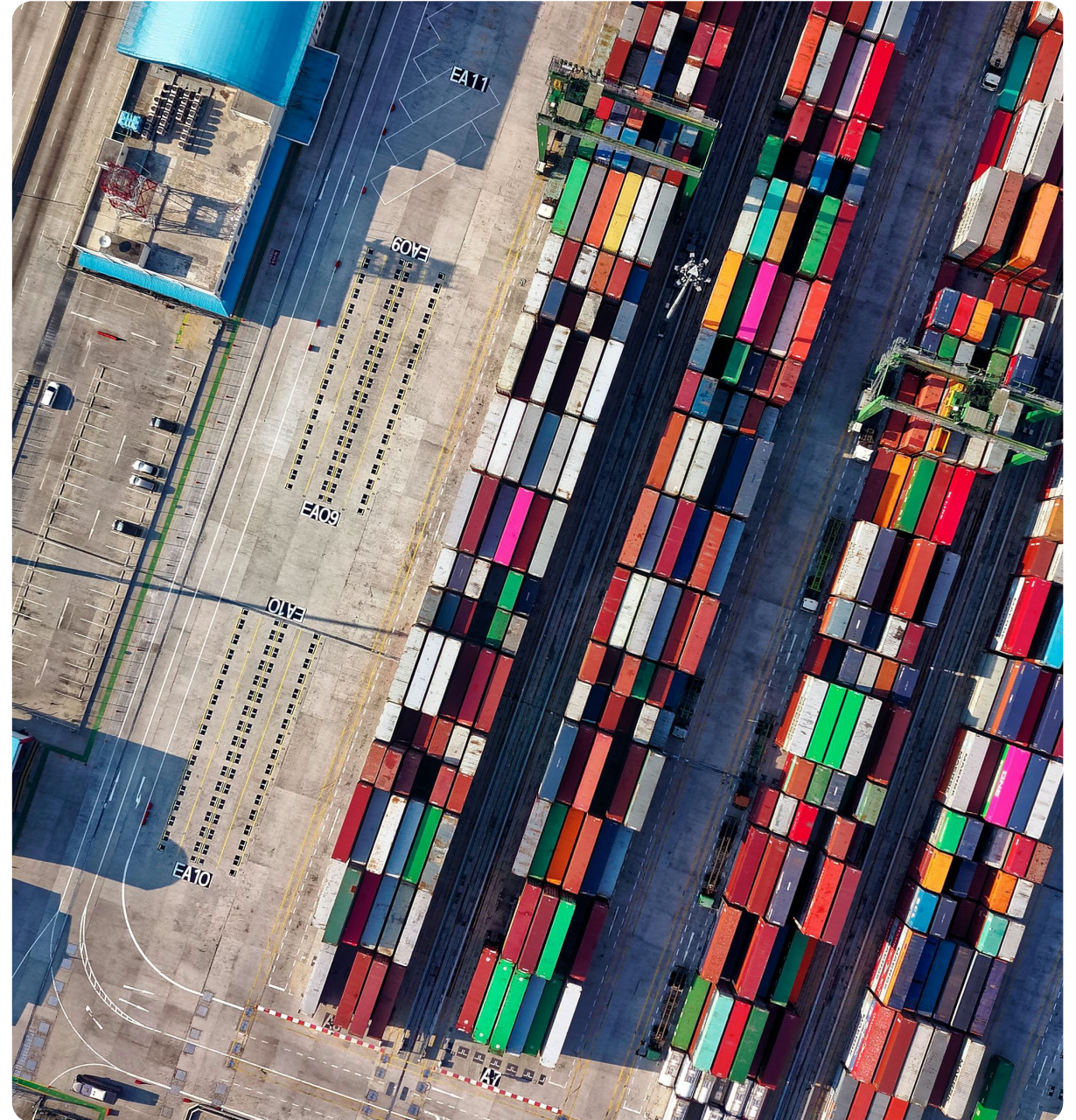
- Program focusing on growth of digitalization and data sharing in the Rail Sector in Rotterdam;
