UIRR - Overview




- Members: Combined Transport Operators and Terminal Managers

- UIRR founded in 1970- seat in Brussels since 1988




Combined Transport of UIRR Members: 1989 – 2013









Primary energy needs and CO₂ emissions of modes












Total external cost of modes






Ro-Ro and smaller vessels perform worse

Combined Transport:


The most efficient way to insert ecologically sustainable modes of transport – like electric rail, inland navigation and shortsea shipping – into long(er) distance transport-chains
