Regulation 2017/2177 – under Directive 2012/34

Service Facility Statement: a standardized General Terms and Conditions for all facilities

- Physical description
- Services and commercial conditions
- Application process, allocation rules, etc.
- Dynamic information: capacity availability, TCR/vis maior, new services, advertisement for lease

Entry into force: 30 June 2018: SFS template

1 January 2019: exemption applications

1 June 2019: compliance for all



September 2017: Member States approve Implementing Regulation 2177/2017

October 2017: RNE Network Statement WG begins work on SFS template
(based on mandate from the European Commission)

---publication of information: IM NS or Common EU Portal

November 2018: Common Portal contract advertised by EU Commission

22 February 2018: stakeholder consultation on RNE NS WG draft


April 2018: contract signed for development of Common Portal

---UIRR part of successfully bidding consortium

June 2019: Common Portal ready

Reminder: Last Mile Study on CT terminals developed the Rail Freight Locations Portal
in 2015-16

1. 18 existing – incomplete/imperfect databases and portals were examined
2. Stakeholders were surveyed and several dozens interviewed one-on-one
3. Expectations of market actors developed
4. Technical architecture designed and demonstrator portal produced
5. Operating model for portal was developed


